**PHOTOS:** In June, Spanish teacher Mary Beth Corey, Nina Wurzelbacher '17, Megan Wade '17, Sarah Rolfes '16, and MC Corey '16 attended a mission trip to Chimaltenango, Guatemala. While there, they worked and stayed at the Agua Viva Children's Home, a 14-acre compound that is home to over 80 orphaned or abandoned children. Work at the home included tiling an outdoor shelter at the school, preparing planter boxes for tomatoes, organizing donations, and digging a 9-foot deep cistern to be used for watering the gardens during the dry season. The students were also responsible for planning, playing games and doing crafts with children at Agua Viva before school, during recess, after school and in the evenings.

Another group of students went on a mission trip to St. Bonaventure Indian Mission & School in Thoreau, New Mexico. The group included Abbey Beck '16, Brianna Brumfield '17, Olivia Jones '16, Audrey Laiveling '17, Alexis Lambers '17, Maddie Peters '17, Alexis Raker '16, Ginny Sabers '18 and Hannah Schwaeble '17, and was led by Sandy Howe, SC and Jay Villing. This was a unique opportunity to be in the Navajo Indian Reservation. Students, staff and chaperones who attended helped in building and repairing homes, learned about the culture and participated in the wonderful service St. Bonaventure offers to so many.

## From the Seton Science labs to the UC Emergency Department

**A**s a student at Seton High School, it didn't take Dr. Sara Fraley Continenza '07 long to realize what her own unique strengths were. "I loved my science classes and learning how the human body worked," she said. "My time at Seton really helped me develop this passion, and I had some great teachers and classes that fostered this," said Sara, who graduated as the valedictorian of her class. "From Mr. Heil teaching us exactly how rainbows were formed in Physics class to making a giant cell with playdough in Mr. Buschelmann's AP Biology class and learning how all the organelles contribute to making the body work, there were many fascinating things I learned at Seton that encouraged me to pursue a science career."

The culture of community service and compassion at Seton was another pillar that helped her to identify her strengths. She saw that when someone was in need, the Seton community came together to help them without ever expecting anything in return. "Some of the first times my eyes were opened to the social injustices and disparities in our community were through community service projects, mission trips and activities through Seton," she explained. "It was through many of these experiences that I realized I wanted a career where I could help people."

Sara said she also learned to work through challenges to reach her goals. "Whether the challenge before me was the American History AP test or running a 5K cross country race, I realized that the best things in life often take daily commitment and hard work," she explained. "The perseverance I learned at Seton helped me succeed throughout college and medical school and is integral in my career."

Alongside Sara through their years at Seton was Dr. Kirsten Lange Koch '07. The two of them were in several of the same classes and have so many great memories from their four years here. Like Sara, Kirsten recalls the classes and activities that she was involved in and how they brought out her unique gifts and strengths. "I was always encouraged to push myself at Seton," said Kirsten, who was the salutatorian of her class. "I embraced the opportunities to take AP classes that challenged me and prepared me for college-level curriculum. My teachers assigned creative yet challenging projects that engaged me in the material."

Kirsten also found that Seton was a place that created a safe and supportive atmosphere to grow in confidence. "Being part of the Kairos team my senior year really helped me get out of my comfort zone and find my own strengths that I could share with others."

When it came time to choosing a college, major and ultimately a career path, both Kirsten and Sara knew that the medical field was where they could use their gifts and talents to make a difference.

Kirsten attended The Ohio State University. She majored in Biology with a focus on Pre-Med, and minored in both Sexuality Studies and Psychology. "Taking some electives at Seton helped me to know that I wanted to have two minors," Kirsten said. "I think this helped me stay well-rounded."

She then attended the University of Louisville School of Medicine where she earned her Doctor of Medicine degree.

Sara went to college at Saint Louis University where she majored in Biology. She then went on to Case Western Reserve University Medical School.

Both Sara and Kirsten are now in their second year of residency back here in Cincinnati, and they were able to work together in the UC Emergency Department in May of this year. "The ED is Sara's main program, but for me it was a rotation outside of my usual environment, so I was excited to see a familiar face," Kirsten said. "She was just as friendly and enthusiastic as I remembered her being in high school and it was wonderful to work with her again."

Sara says she recalls meeting Kirsten for the first time in Mr. Collins' Freshman Honors English class.

And now, years later, she saw her name on the Emergency Department schedule where they were able to work some of the same shifts. “I have always admired Kirsten for her kindness, attention to details, and work ethic,” explained Sara. “I witnessed her going the extra mile for her patients in the ED by calling primary care providers to set up follow-up appointments and looking up information to help answer patients’ questions. I smile to myself knowing she is still the same caring and diligent Kirsten I knew at Seton.”

On her normal rotation, Kirsten is a Family Medicine Resident Physician with Christ Hospital and enjoys the variety in family medicine as well as watching her patients grow and make life changes for the better. “I get to work in all the major fields of medicine,” she explained. “Sometimes I’m a hospital medicine physician, sometimes I’m a pediatrician, sometimes I’m an obstetrician, and other days I’m a community doctor.”

Sara is an emergency medicine resident at University of Cincinnati Medical Center, or UCMC, and an Air Care Flight Doctor. She travels on the Air Care helicopter to help care for very sick or badly injured patients that need to emergently receive intensive care or

be transferred to a trauma center like UCMC. “Patient care is undoubtedly the best part of my job,” Sara said. “When a patient ends up in the Emergency Department it is typically one of the worst days of their life. I’m glad that I am able to be there to help care for them.”

These two Saints did not set out to be superheroes; however, we are sure that people throughout the community feel that they are. They each can look back and see the ways that Seton helped them to discover their unique strengths and gifts and they are both proud to call Seton and Cincinnati their home. “The culture of service and helping all people is interwoven through both the Seton community and medical community,” Sara said. “I’m blessed to be a part of both.”

# Honor Flight

For more than 10 years, Cheryl Kuhn Popp '66 has been involved with Honor Flight Tri-State. This organization brings World War II veterans age 65 and older to Washington, D.C. at no cost to veterans so that they can visit the World War II Memorial that was completed in 2004. "So many veterans of the greatest generation would not talk about war experiences and did not get a proper thanks for their service after World War II," said Cheryl, who is a licensed pilot. "By the time the memorial was completed in 2004 many of them could not go to see it because of failing health, finances or family priorities." Out of those circumstances grew the mission of Honor Flight. Since 2009

she has served as director of the organization and has been involved with over 35 flights. She has also been a guardian on some of the flights – these are younger veterans who serve as companions to the older, honored veterans. Cheryl was also recently a key player in the first-ever All-Women Honor Flight in 2015. "We took 150 veterans who served as nurses, clerical help, pilots, dispatchers and other non-combat roles in World War II, Korea and Vietnam," she explained. The younger guardians had all served more recently in Desert Storm and Operation Iraqi Freedom. "The energy on that flight was amazing," said Cheryl. "There was so much admiration from younger vets who were so appreciative to the pioneers and heroes that opened the doors for women in our military."

Cheryl has co-written two published books: "Legacy of Courage: True Stories of Honor Flight Veterans" and "Legacy of Courage II: New Stories of Honor Flight Veterans". "Writing these books has been an incredibly rewarding experience," Cheryl said.

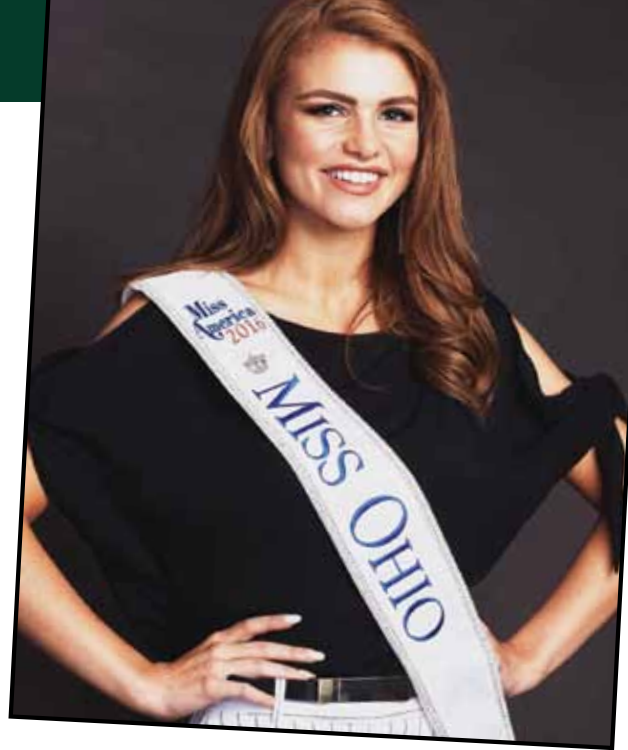
**How long have you been doing pageants?** I entered my first pageant at age 17 in March 2015. This is my second year being a part of the Miss America Organization.

### What strong message do you want to convey to the young women of today?

I want to live in a world where beauty is defined as a diversity of body types, skin color, heights and shapes that result from living a physically, mentally, and emotionally healthy lifestyle. My vision is to be at the forefront of helping to change the way women are represented in media and advertising so that teens can find unedited and unfiltered role models to emulate that are authentic, healthy, confident and true-to-diverse sizes, shapes and ethnicity. This is important because three of the most common mental-health problems among girls (eating disorders, depression or depressed mood/self-esteem) are linked to the presentation of women in the media. We are exhausting ourselves trying to look like edited images and being bombarded with outdated, unrealistic and unhealthy standards of beauty that are affecting our overall well-being.

### What do you hope to accomplish over the next year as Miss Ohio?

One of my goals is to raise awareness for photo manipulation and continue my #beautyunedited movement. I want to help get the "Truth in Advertising" act passed through Congress. I also plan to visit many Children's Hospitals as the state ambassador for Children's Miracle Network. Additionally, I'm looking forward to presenting my program "Conquering the Confidence Curve" to schools across the state. I also want to promote the Miss Ohio Program. I would love to get more young women from Cincinnati involved.

# Scholarship Honors '34 Grad

## *A family legacy continues*

Even at 100 years young, Martha Donelan Trauth '34 is still reminiscing about her high school years at Seton. As a member of the third graduating class, Martha has a very special claim to fame. She wrote the music to Seton's school song, "At Thy Call". Among all of her fond memories, this one may be her favorite. Each senior was given an assignment in English class to write the words to a school song. The poem written by Martha's classmate, Margaret Whitehead '34, was chosen. Then the seniors in music class were given

the assignment to write the music to the song, and Martha's was chosen. She even got to sing the song at the Cincinnati May Festival Chorus.

Martha has shared that story over the years with her seven daughters, all of whom are also proud Seton alums. Martha's Seton experience as well as the education each of her daughters received, is why the family decided to set up the Martha Donelan Trauth Scholarship Fund in 1996. Dr. Denise Trauth '65 recalls her mother's 80th birthday celebration that year. "It was a milestone birthday and we wanted to do something special. My sister, Charlene Trauth '62, proposed the idea of a named Seton Scholarship Fund, and we all agreed it was the perfect way to honor mom," Denise explained.

*"Mom was adamant that the scholarship recipient would be not based solely on merit, but also on need. She knew that a Seton education could be a game changer for a young woman and wanted a scholarship in her name to have that kind of benefit."*

Dr. Eileen Trauth '69 said she loved her time at Seton for many reasons. "We had the opportunity to try out things that interested us in both the classroom and in extracurricular activities," she explained. "Four years of strong mathematics, years of foreign language study, rigorous English classes, participating in the library club, debate club and class and student council leadership – all of these experiences helped to prepare me for the academic and leadership roles I took on after leaving Seton."

In addition to excelling in academics while at Seton, the involvement and leadership roles of the Trauth sisters included everything from homeroom rep, editor of the Green Blazer, class president, president of the art club, and secretary of student council to theater, music, stage crew, Debate Club, Library Club, World Affairs Club, Glee Club, Orchestra, and more.

At the time that the Trauth sisters were in high school in the 60s and 70s, the opportunities and career choices for young women after high school were not as extensive as they are today, said Dr. Suzanne Trauth '67. "Being at an all-girls high school removed the day-to-day concerns about competing with or impressing male students," Suzanne explained. "Seton allowed girls to excel, to grow academically and emotionally, and to blossom as a female." Eileen echoed those feelings. "Seton gave girls the opportunity to pursue unfettered excellence," she said.

There were three essential things at Seton that helped Denise figure out her strengths, who she was and what she wanted to do with her life: "The fabulous faculty who were great teachers and in many ways, life coaches; the cultural environment that supported student success; and a student body that was truly a community," said Denise, who is still friends with several Seton classmates despite the fact that she hasn't lived in Cincinnati in 45 years.

Additionally, the timeless message of the Sisters of Charity was always communicated to the students. "Because many of the teachers were Sisters of Charity, there was a selflessness and compassion that was also communicated. Seton fostered a caring, giving culture," added Denise.

were inspirational. Mr. Price in particular really pushed me and I learned so much at Seton."

Dr. Jeanette Trauth '71 also felt greatly influenced by her teachers at Seton. "In my sophomore year I had S. Barbara Counts for geometry, and I remember that it was the first time I loved a math class and did well in it," she explained. "She was a wonderful teacher and had a gift for explaining concepts in ways that demystified the content." Having S. Judith Metz for some of her social studies classes also made a big impression on Jeanette, who took a challenging 20th Century History class during her senior year. As a college freshman at the University of Dayton the following year, Jeanette took a 400-level class. When the professor found out that she was only a freshman he asked her how she had the background for this course. She was able to confidently reply, "Oh, I had a lot of this material in high school." S. Judith helped Jeanette decide to major in History and Political Science in college. "This subsequently affected my decision to focus on public administration in my graduate studies," she said.

"I always liked science and math, but she asked me if I had ever considered engineering," explained Kathleen. "There were no engineers in my family and I'm not sure if I even knew that it existed."

These strong sisters attribute their success and attitudes about all-girls, Catholic education to the values and mantras their parents stressed to them. "My father's constant mantra was the importance for women to be well-educated and to be able to speak out in support of their faith," said Jeanette.

As the youngest sister, Kathleen saw how her parents stressed the importance of education. "We grew up in a large family where my dad was in business for himself and there wasn't a lot of money to throw around. He used the analogy of mountain climbers and said that we needed to help each other complete our educations, particularly with the older sisters helping out the younger ones," she explained.

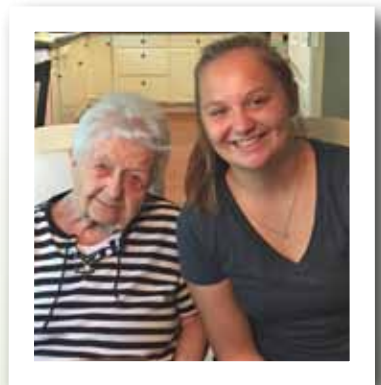

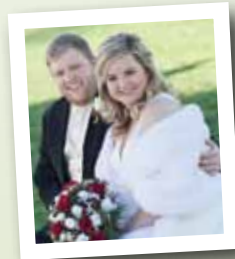

# Giving Our Time and Using Our Gifts

Wherever it may be that alumnae choose to live in this world, Seton High School has prepared them to excel in life, to hear God's voice and to do God's will. Here you can read about a Saint doing amazing things all over the world.

## Alumnae Spotlight

### Ashley Niemann '12

During her last semester of college at Miami University, Ashley Niemann '12 began thinking about doing an international volunteer trip. A friend told her about a great opportunity with Growth International Volunteer Excursions, or GIVE. This adventure through GIVE led Ashley to Thailand, where she spent three weeks volunteering and living amongst the Hill Tribe people located in the northern region of Chiang Mai. "I worked alongside some of the friendliest people I've ever met," said Ashley, who taught English as a second language to the school children and helped the locals with sustainable construction projects.

"As a GIVE volunteer, I assisted grade school children with English because they have had very little exposure to it and communication was difficult," she explained. "The Thai language has a very different alphabet so there is no easy way to translate." But love and compassion have no language so Ashley felt that it was easy to show how much she cared and wanted to help. "I feel my greatest contribution to the children I worked with was the many smiles we shared. The children received valuable exposure to English and learned some basic English words, but I received the immeasurable experience inside the classrooms of seeing how difficult and disadvantaged life could be for the people who live in this isolated area. The students live at the school and don't see their families for extended periods of time, so it felt good to be able to show them love and support."

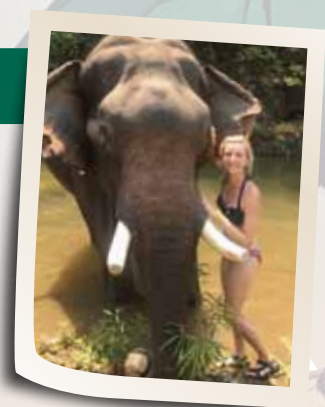
In addition to teaching English, Ashley and her team partnered with local community leaders to build a sustainable foundation out of water bottles for a water tank. The tank can hold up to 75,000 gallons of water. "The water tank now supplies 70 families with clean water for cooking, drinking and cleaning," Ashley explained. "Before the tank, families had to rely on the village chief to deliver a limited amount of water to each individual family."

The water project needed approximately 7,000 empty 1.5L recycled bottles in order to create a tank six meters in diameter. Ashley and her team packed 1,500 bottles with tight sand during one week. "It was exhausting and at the end of the day we were covered in sweat, sand and bugs; however, it was a wonderful thing to be a part of knowing that these families would soon have access to clean water."

The GIVE team also helped to build bamboo rafts to be used to float down the river from village to village. "We learned about their cultural traditions and even participated in some of their tribal dance festivities," Ashley explained. "Most villages practice Buddhism but the one I spent the most time in practiced Christianity. I went to Mass with them on Sunday mornings and I will never forget the feeling of holding hands with strangers during prayer and realizing that although we don't speak the same language, we can understand and feel God's universal love."

Being able to see Thailand from various perspectives is something that Ashley treasures. In addition to volunteering, she had the opportunity to trek seven miles through the jungle to find a mahout's elephant. A mahout in South and Southeast Asia is a person who works with, rides, and tends to elephants. "We walked with the elephant down to the local river and then got to feed and bathe three elephants," she said. "Going through the jungle and then swimming with these giant, beautiful creatures allowed me to see the elephants from a Thai's point of view."

Ashley recalls her years at Seton as ones that helped her gain confidence and find her strengths. "I know that without my foundation at Seton I wouldn't be embarking on such adventures," she said. 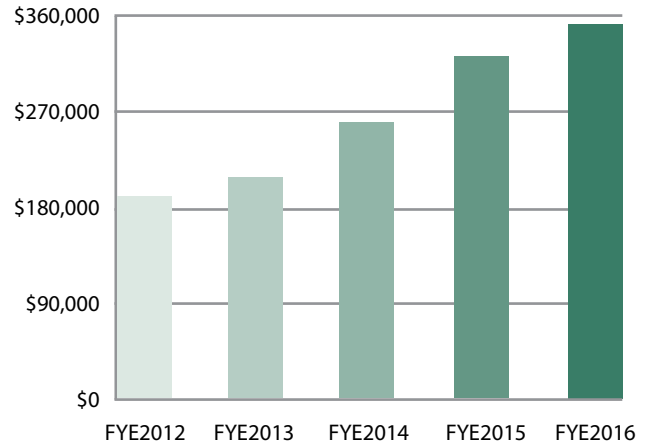

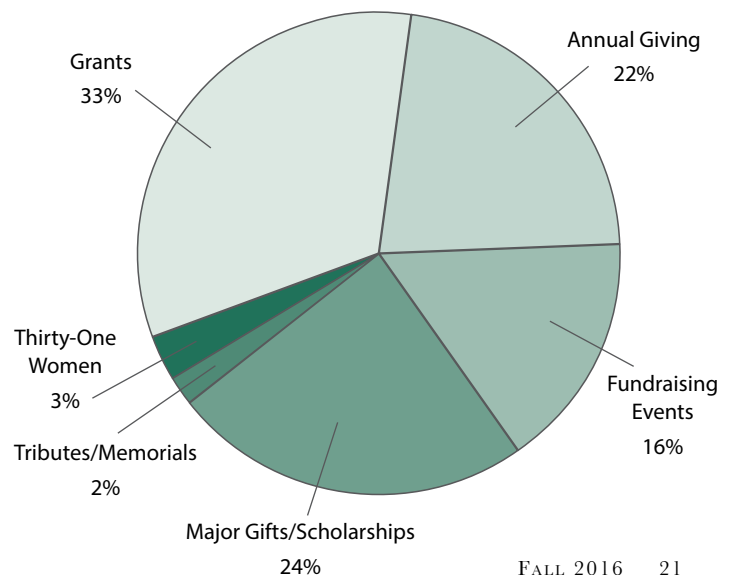
