

SOARING SETON SUCCESS



When Suzanne Glatthaar Powell graduated from Seton High School in 1988, she was prepared and ready to soar into a bright future – both literally and figuratively. With an amazing and well-rounded four years of high school behind her, Suzanne left Seton with an exceptional education, accomplished experiences, life lessons, and life-long friends and memories. As with every young woman who has graduated as a Saint, the sky was the limit for Suzanne, and she was ready to take off.

One month after graduating, Suzanne began flight training to become a professional, commercial pilot. This involved a series of levels, which included licenses and ratings that require a certain amount and specific types of flying time. She did this all while attending college. “I obtained my private license six months after high school graduation, and following that I continued to build my time,” said Suzanne, who earned her undergrad degree in Aviation Administration at Northern Kentucky University and also helped at Seton as an assistant soccer coach and swim coach during college. She next received her commercial license and multi-engine rating. She then traveled to South Florida to train and receive her

Certified Flight Instructors Certificate, and her final license was the Airline Transport Pilot license, the highest license for any pilot. From there she traveled to Southern California to earn her flight engineering rating. She also earned a bachelor’s degree from California Coast University.

Being focused, driven and full of energy were qualities that Suzanne also possessed as a student at Seton. She played both soccer and basketball and was a member of Pep Club in addition to focusing on strong academics. She recalls teachers inspiring and encouraging her along the way. “Sister Jeanine Marie Holthouse was instrumental in helping me believe in myself academically and become a leader,” Suzanne said. “She taught me well and also taught me how to teach others. I watched her closely and she always knew how to adjust her teaching style to the needs of the individual who was on the receiving end of her tutelage.”

Another positive, influential teacher was Mr. Frank Rotter. “More than just helping me believe in myself academically, Mr. Rotter taught me the importance of respecting all people in simple ways that we all could take notice of and do,” Suzanne explained. “Anyone who knew Mr. Rotter knew that he always addressed his students with the title ‘Miss’ and their last name. He never addressed his students by their first name. I, never being shy or quiet, asked him one day why he did this. His explanation was

one of many life lessons that he taught. He said, 'I address you as Miss Glatthaar because I do so out of respect for you and for all of my students and peers.' It was a simple response that said so much about him, and it was a great lesson for all of us to always show respect to every individual."

Even though she did not realize it at the time, Suzanne's high school years in Spanish proved to give her a good foundation of the language that would benefit her in her career as a pilot. While living in San Diego from 1992-1994, she worked for a man who was originally from Mexico City. She worked hard to improve her Spanish speaking skills with him and with others when she had layovers in Guadalajara and Saltillo, Mexico. From that job through today, Suzanne has relied on her Spanish, and says that she continues to use those skills on virtually every trip. From helping redirect an elderly passenger who did not speak any English to the correct flight, to translating a lunch order for a passenger at the food court, there are always opportunities. "All of these occasions were made possible by my two Spanish teachers, Ms. Long and Mrs. Brewer, who gave me the foundation, respect and enthusiasm to embrace and move forward with the language."

That continued respect for others, in addition to a very compassionate desire to serve, is a huge part of Suzanne's life today. She, her husband, Michael (Oak Hills '88), and her twin boys, Zachary and Gabriel, are very involved with service work. "We, as Christians, are called to spread the Gospel, and one of the best ways to do this is to serve and show our love," Suzanne said. "I am honored to be the hands and feet of God here on earth and be a conduit for his love."

The Powell family sponsors two children in Nicaragua through Compassion International, and they have a planned mission trip there in the fall. Additionally, Suzanne has traveled to New Orleans twice and worked with Habitat for Humanity to help rebuild houses after the devastation of Hurricane Katrina. Suzanne looks at scriptures as God's inspiring desire for each of us. "There are many scriptures that speak to me as I prepare and engage in mission work," she explained. "I draw my strength from Matthew 20:28 – 'Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as ransom for many.'" Suzanne added that another scripture she reflects on is, "Colossians 3:23 – 'Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters.'" Because the communities that Suzanne engages with through mission work are not always receptive to her and the teams she works with, another personally powerful scripture is Isaiah 65:1. "I revealed myself to those who did not ask for me; I was found by those who did not seek me," she added.

In Suzanne's current professional career, she is a Captain for Canadair Regional Jet based at CVG Airport as well as a Pilot Ground Instructor. She had been flying for over 25 years professionally before she flew someone that she personally knew. "That person happened to be Mr. Dan Riestenberg, my high school soccer coach and the father of Stacey Riestenberg Reeder '87 and Sara Riestenberg Niederhausen '90." Since then, she has flown a few other Saints, including Trish Knoerzer Duebber '81 and Kim Ammon Scheper '87. She has also had the privilege of flying with fellow pilot Cheryl Kuhn Popp '66, and recently connected with Rhea Buttlerwerth '09 who is a flight attendant. "Reconnecting with people from Seton, whether in the community or in my career, is always a reminder of the importance of a strong sisterhood," Suzanne said. "A true sense of confidence is important and a false one can be dangerous. It is important to build your sisters-in-Christ all around you. Learn all that you can and keep an open mind because you never know from whom you can be learning. Seton taught me these important values and I continue to put them to work every day in my personal and professional life."


Seton High School is proud of Mr. Jason Berling, who was selected as a 2017 James Madison Foundation Fellow. A James Madison Fellowship funds up to \$24,000 of each Fellow's course of study towards a master's degree. It specifically supports the graduate study of American history by aspiring and experienced secondary school teachers of American history, American government and civics.

Jason was among 52 James Madison Fellows who were selected in competition with applicants from each of the 50 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.

Jason currently teaches United States History, AP United States History, and AP American Government and Politics.

He is looking forward to how this opportunity will benefit his students here at Seton.

"Even more important than my own interest in the material is the fact that this will make me a better teacher," said Jason, who began classes for the Ashland Master of Arts in American History and Government Program this past summer. "I will get to focus and drill down into the content via primary

source documents, getting deep into the actual history and beyond the simple and boring traditional approach to history. This provides me the opportunity to get into the heads of the people who were directly involved with the history itself, and then be able to bring those skills and experiences back to the students of Seton High School."

Among the many exciting aspects of this program, Jason is especially looking forward to spending four weeks in Georgetown during the summer of 2018 where he will get to hear several renowned lecturers on American History and Government. In addition, he will attend sessions at

historical places. "I'll be learning in places like Montpelier where James Madison's home is, Monticello where Thomas Jefferson's home is, and Mount Vernon where George Washington's home is," Jason explained. "There will also be sessions in the United States Capital Building, the White House and the Supreme Court."

The focus of both the Madison Fellowship Program and the Ashland Master of Arts in American History and Government is on building a better citizenship by creating teachers who have a deep and thorough understanding of the original documents and how to use them. "While this is the way I already try to teach the class, I will now be building my ability to teach the students how to read, interpret and use history," he explained. "This skill is transferrable, meaning that what the students will be doing and learning goes far beyond the recalling of simple facts."

Jason's goals focus on finding ways to present American History and American Government to the all-female student audience here at Seton. "I want to see my students studying social sciences, running for political office, and developing a sense of empowerment and political efficacy."

A SETON LIFE-SAVING LEGACY

Tracy Coletta Collins '01 faced devastating news in 2011 when her daughter, Natalie, was diagnosed with a Wilms tumor on both kidneys. She was only three years old at the time. After only a few rounds of chemotherapy Natalie went into septic shock, and doctors were not sure why. Her left kidney had to be removed, and she spent 12 weeks in the hospital. It was then discovered that her right kidney was damaged beyond repair, and the search began for a donor. Adele Hartwig Fritsch '86, her great aunt, was a perfect match and became her donor, and a successful transplant took place on October 9, 2012. Natalie is currently nine years old and in the fourth grade at St. Aloysius Gonzaga, and she was a member of the Seton Twinkles Dance Team last year.

A Seton Star

Congratulations to **Kalie Kaimann '15** who was casted as Dorothy in the NATIONAL TOUR of *The Wizard of Oz!* We knew Kalie was a star when she was at Seton as she wowed audiences every time she took the stage. Whether it was at a school assembly, showcase night, or as the lead in the Seton-Elder Performing Arts Series spring musicals, Kalie has always had undeniable star talent and stage presence. She went on to attend Xavier University and has continued theater with The Children's Theater of Cincinnati and Cincinnati Landmark Productions.

Kalie found out about open auditions and headed to New York City for her chance. "I made a special trip there for the open singers call," explained Kalie. "Since there are no audition appointments, whoever gets there first gets seen. They started seeing people at 10:00 a.m. and when I arrived at 5:00 a.m. there was already a line!"

There were two days of general open auditions with an average of 300 people per day. Kalie had only about 30 seconds in the room with the directors. She made it to callbacks and there were only seven girls called for Dorothy. "We each sang 'Over the Rainbow', and they cut that number down to three girls, and then we each had to read from the

script," she said. "Then it was down to just me and one other girl. I was there for eight hours, and at the end of the day the directors simply told us that they would be in touch."

It ended up being two months until Kalie received an official offer for the role of Dorothy. "I was so excited! It was a dream come true!"

Rehearsals start this fall in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. Previews begin mid-October in Alma, Arkansas, and the official opening night is October 27, 2017 in Lexington, Kentucky. Kalie's contract runs through August 2018. "We will be touring the United States and Canada until May 2018, and the remaining four months we will be performing at The Dutch Apple Dinner Theater in Lancaster, Pennsylvania," she said.

From there, Kalie hopes to continue to soar to stardom. "After I finish the tour, I plan on moving to New York City. My goal is to be a working actress on Broadway," she explained. "I was lucky enough to have had some really amazing roles while I was at Seton. Each role that I played challenged me to portray a different kind of character, which allowed me to grow creatively and sharpen my musical theater skills. Seton really helped me to grow in confidence and artistically, and I'm so grateful!"

The upgrades that took place this past summer are:


- New roof for entire facility





One of the greatest things about being a Seton Saint is the true sense of sisterhood that comes with it. From the first days of high school through decades beyond graduation, Saints find themselves crossing paths and being there for one another along the way. Helping, guiding and encouraging a Seton sister is a natural feeling – whether you are on the giving end or the receiving end – and it is definitely a blessing to all of our alums. Sometimes life's coincidences are great reminders of how special it is to call ourselves Seton Saints.

At the Big-Little Sister Picnic in 2008, Megan McDonald Katt '09 helped Anne Pace '12 feel right at home here at Seton as Anne's Big Sister. As the year rolled out, they were both on Seton's Track and Field team and in some of the same clubs as well, like Campus Ministry and Community Service. Megan graduated at the end of the school year with the honor of receiving the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Award – Seton's highest award given. Four years later, Anne was the recipient of the same prestigious award for her graduating class.

"I was asked to help with the course due to the experiences I've had with my current job with Cincinnati Public Schools," said Megan, who services two preschool Autism classrooms and a primary multiple disabilities classroom. "I was a bit nervous on the first day of class, so it was quite a relief to see a familiar face!" That face was Anne, who was a student in the class.

Anne is on course to graduate in 2018 with her Master's Degree in Speech-Language Pathology and become a speech-language pathologist. "Seton gave me a great foundation in academics, faith, leadership and service, and allowed me to develop critical thinking skills that I have carried with me throughout college, graduate school and in my life," she explained. "Megan was a part of the beginning of my Seton experience. She encouraged me to get involved and gave me advice on how to make my years at Seton be the best they could be. She was a great role model and did a great job of passing Seton traditions down to me."

Years later, Megan is helping guide Anne in the classroom and hopes to continue to help her in the future. That's what the Seton sisterhood is all about. "I hope to be there for Anne in whatever capacity she needs. Anne is truly a Super Saint, and I see her doing very well for herself in her career," said Megan. "The transition from graduate school into practice can be a bit daunting, and I hope I can be a resource for her as she navigates the system during this process. I also hope to be a mentor for Anne once she is established in her career, and I look forward to sharing with her the things that I've learned."




