HEALING OVER TIME

WITH A PASSION
TO HELP OTHERS



An anyone who has lost a loved one knows that it takes more than just time to heal. Sometimes it is through the grieving process, the support of a community, and a desire to turn pain into helping others, where faith returns and healing begins. Amanda Jacobs '15 knows how true this is. When she was only 14 years old, she lost her mother unexpectedly. Sheila Jacobs was only 49 when she drove home on a Friday afternoon from her job as a preschool teacher. She pulled out of the parking lot, had a heart attack and died instantly.

Amanda says much of that day is a blur. Her grandpa picked her up from school; and she and her siblings, Ashley '13 and Matthew, met their dad at the hospital. "My dad told my sister, brother and I that the doctors did everything they could, but they could not save her. We then gathered around my mom and said a Hail Mary," Amanda said. "I will never forget that feeling of holding her hand for that last time," she said.

Amanda recalls her mom's strong faith and religious nature. "We had always said prayers daily with my mom, and we went to Mass regularly as a family," she explained. "My whole identity of God was through her.

So when she died, I think I felt like that relationship with God died for me as well."

The following hours showed the Jacobs family just how incredibly powerful the love, support and prayers of an entire community can be. "One of our neighbors picked us up from the hospital because we didn't want to go back to our house without our dad. Later we went to my grandparents' house with my dad where all of my aunts, uncles and cousins were gathered together." When they finally got back to their own house, there were several friends and families inside waiting for them. That love and support continued for weeks and months. "People brought us so many things, and many friends just wanted to be there for us so we wouldn't be alone," she explained.

It was through the process of grieving that Amanda found little ways to begin healing. One of her teachers at the time, Mrs. Shelly Henke Kahny '87, was a strong force in that healing process. "Mrs. Kahny was very in tune with me and could always tell the moments and the days that I was having a hard time," Amanda explained. "Whenever I needed time, or words of comfort, she gave that to me. She really helped me through that time."

As she headed into high school, Amanda got involved with clubs, mission trips and volleyball. She also participated in Kairos and went on to become a leader. “It was through the people and experiences at Seton that I was pushed to be my best and to not give up,” Amanda explained. “The teachers pushed me academically, and they also taught me how to keep going when things got tough.”

Through her Kairos experience, Amanda grew closer with her cousin, Katie Jacobs ’15. Katie was on the giving team for Kairos, and during that retreat Amanda learned that when her mom passed away and she was at the hospital with her family, Katie and several relatives were all together praying the rosary. “This was at the same time that we were praying and holding my mom’s hand for the last time,” Amanda said. “Finding this out was really special.”

Losing her mother is something that changed Amanda forever, and she soon began realizing that she wanted to take her pain and turn it into something that could make a positive difference for other families. It was through the process of grieving and growing that she embraced her faith again and wanted to share her story.

“Seton taught me to follow my passions without fear, but with faith,” said Amanda. She didn’t play volleyball her senior year so she found that her schedule allowed for much more time to focus on raising awareness. “I had always wanted to do the Heart Mini Marathon, and I decided to incorporate this into my Senior Project.”

She began volunteering with The American Heart Association and started sharing her story. “It was truly amazing to be able to spread awareness through my story, see the emotion on women’s faces and know that the message was resonating,” explained Amanda, who raised

over \$10,000 that year and was the honored speaker at The American Heart Association’s Go Red for Women luncheon. “Raising awareness quickly

became my passion. Knowing that I was keeping my mom’s memory alive and educating other mothers was powerful.”

During her freshman year at Xavier University, Amanda began interning for the Go Red for Women Campaign. It was also during this year that she attended Xavier’s Club Fair and noticed that there weren’t any clubs for heart disease and heart health. So Amanda made it her mission to start a club on campus.

The club became official in February of her sophomore year, and she named it *Xavier University One Heart*. “The club’s focus is to raise awareness of the signs and symptoms of heart disease and the risks even at a young age. We have brought survivors in to speak at events, advocated on National Go Red Day by handing out buttons and educational materials, and taught Hands-Only CPR,” said Amanda, who added that they hope to add some physical activity events this year as well. “The best part of creating this club is seeing people whose lives have been affected by heart disease come to our club and feel like they have found their place at Xavier, and that’s something special.”

Amanda continues to raise awareness through One Heart, The American Heart Association and as an adult leader for Kairos at Seton. She remembers the first few events she spoke at being very emotional. “It was hard to talk in front of people about this, and I cried a lot,” she said. “But when women began coming up to me after events to talk to me, I realized how proud my mom would be; and I was proud of myself, too. I don’t care how emotional I get now because it shows how real and deep the emotions of losing a mother at such a young age are.” Amanda doesn’t want other families to go through that pain. “Each time I get up in front of a crowd I hope they realize that they have a second chance that my mom did not. I want to make them think twice about their health and to slow down as mothers. My mom was a busy 49-year-old who had no idea that she had heart disease. My hope is that women listen to their bodies and get familiar with the signs and symptoms so that they can detect a problem before it is too late.”

Seton 360^o Construction Update



Exciting upgrades took place over the summer here at Seton! We are off to a COOL start to the school year thanks to the incredible support of the Seton 360 campaign from several donors, including the Sisters of Charity, alumnae and friends of Seton! Despite the high temperatures outside over the past month, students and teachers are now focusing on academics in upgraded classrooms throughout the second and third floors. They are now able to work in an optimal learning environment where newly-painted classrooms are equipped with energy-efficient HVAC, lighting, whiteboards and beautiful new windows. There is also a new parking lot near the Vincent Avenue entrance to the school to accommodate the 12% increase in enrollment.

"I never imagined what a difference these upgrades would make," said junior Maggie Tepe. "It's so much easier to focus and learn in an air-conditioned classroom, and what a difference the new windows and lighting make in the classrooms, hallways and stairwells. It looks like a new school!"

The first two phases of Seton 360 have been fully funded. "We are so very grateful for the incredible generosity and abundance of prayers that have made the success of this campaign possible so far," said Seton High School President Kathy Allen Ciarla. "We are now moving into the general phase and need the support from the entire Seton community to complete the project."

The positive feedback from students, alums and donors who have seen the upgrades has been overwhelming. "This is such an exciting time at Seton! The construction offers our students classrooms and spaces where learning is optimal," said Ciarla. "Incorporating high-efficient lighting and electricity will also help lower utility costs by 38%. Being good ambassadors to our environment and to our generous donors is another example of how we are proud to be green."

Construction for Phase 3 will resume in spring 2019. Upgrades will take place on the first floor and ground floor and will include energy-efficient HVAC, windows and lighting, as well as renovations to Seton's Performance Hall, restrooms and cafeteria. Congratulations to Loretta Blaut '14 who has racked up some incredible accomplishments during her career at the University of Cincinnati! During the 2018 indoor season she placed first at the American Athletic Conference (AAC) championships in Birmingham AL, setting a new meet record of 1.87m or 6'1.5". At the NCAA Indoor Championship Loretta lost in a jump-off and placed second. During the outdoor season, Loretta was named Field Scholar Athlete of the year, and won the Cincinnati Women's Sports Association College Athlete of the Year award for track and field. At the outdoor AAC



Championships, Loretta jumped 1.88m, which is 6'2" – breaking the meet record, facility record, and UC's school record! "I was honored to be named the most outstanding field performer for both the indoor and outdoor conference meets," said Loretta. "I tied for second at the NCAA outdoor championship meet, and finally wrapped up my season competing

for Team USA in Toronto, Canada where I placed third and brought home the bronze medal." Loretta will be back for her last indoor season this year as a grad student at UC obtaining her MBA. "My time at Seton prepared me to excel in both athletics and academics while at UC," she explained. "Go Saints and Cats!"

Samantha Monahan '14 was named as one of the University of Cincinnati's Top 100 Graduating Seniors this past spring, and it is very easy to see why. She accomplished some amazing things and embraced her undergraduate years of college with a sense of confidence and adventure that she says she gained much of during her high school years at Seton.

"I was challenged inside and outside of the classroom," explained Samantha, who is a 2018 graduate of the University of Cincinnati's Carl H. Lindner College of Business. "I was involved in a variety of activities at Seton, but my main focus was being part of the nationally-ranked Seton Dance program for all four years. I learned how to be a team player, lead by example and succeed under pressure. Being on that team helped me gain confidence and learn resilience, no matter what life may throw at me."

She also attributes her accounting teacher at Seton, Mrs. Suzanne Rechenberg, with igniting Samantha's passion for what has become her career. "I loved my accounting class! It's one of the reasons I chose it as my major," she said.

The Seton sisterhood is something that Samantha has carried with her. She refers to it as a unique and unbreakable bond. "Some of my favorite memories include holding hands backstage at Nationals before giving one of our best performances of the season," said Samantha, who was part of the team that placed 3rd in the nation for Pom, which was the highest the team had ever placed at that time. "I can still hear my cousin and best friend, Megan Kelly '14, giving those pep talks before going on stage, and I am instantly reminded of those last-minute hugs from Rice Klauke '14 when I see her today."

During her freshman year at UC, Samantha was a member of the UC Varsity Dance Team. The team won a national championship and two world titles as they represented the United States National Dance Team in April 2015. "This was a huge dream of mine to win a Pom title since I joined the program in 5th grade," she explained.

"And to have my cousin, Megan, by my side for this was surreal. She was the one who introduced me to Seton Dance and had been by my side through it all."

Samantha was part of the study abroad program and spent time in Mexico, Australia and Germany. She was honored to also be a PACE Leader for UC's Carl H. Lindner College of Business. "I was in charge of a group of 20 freshman students as they worked on multiple business-themed projects throughout the year. I also led their class breakouts once a week where I was trusted to lead and inspire them."

She was also the director of a new UC student organization called Camp Kesem. "This is a national nonprofit run by passionate student leaders at over 100 universities across the country who provide a free summer camp for kids whose parents have faced or are facing cancer," Samantha explained. "Being co-founder and co-director propelled my professional career and enhanced my knowledge of business while being in charge of 20 college students and leading a camp for over 50 children."

Her involvement with Camp Kesem, as well as accounting co-op rotations with Barnes Dennig and Phillips Edison & Company, attributed to her nominations and awards. UC's Top 100 Graduating Seniors were named in January 2018, and in April 2018 Samantha was honored with UC's Top Outstanding Accounting Student for Professional Experience Award. "I was so humbled to receive this," she said.

Samantha is now working at Phillips Edison & Company, while working towards her Master of Science in Accounting. 

ANNUAL FUND COMPARISON FYE2014-FYE2018


